


Instructions for checking organization information on FindSTDtest.org:

First, go to www.FindSTDtest.org, enter the ZIP code within which your organization is located and press the search button.

Next, look for your organization on the search results page. Note: there may be more than one page of results.

If your organization is listed, follow the directions below. If you do not see your organization, skip down to the next section.

1. Click on the details link, which is located in parenthesis right after the organization's name.
